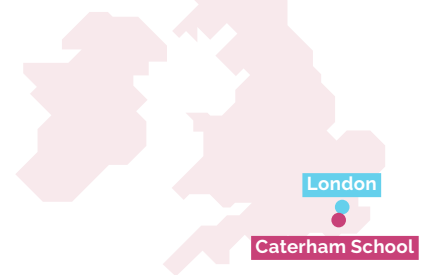

#### On-campus residential accommodation

Students are accommodated in Beechanger house (boys and girls in separate areas).
