### Courses offered

#### Experience Bournemouth

The Experience Bournemouth programme is aimed at teenagers and combines 15 hours of English lessons each week with compulsory day time activities and trips plus some evening activities.

#### Summer Academy: GCSE Prep

The Summer Academy: GCSE Prep programme is aimed at current year 10 students going into year 11 this September and combines catch-up revision in the core GCSE subjects of English, Maths and Science with a lively and engaging programme of team games and outdoor activities designed to bring the curriculum to life.

## Accommodation

### Off-site residence (Charminster)

Charminster residence is located at a 20 minutes' walk from Summer Centre.

Accommodation is arranged in single en-suite rooms.

Students are supervised by Kings residential wardens and internet access is available throughout the residence.

Under 16's receive a room key only and not a main door fob.

### Homestay

Our selected homestays are a bus ride from the centre (usually 25 - 30 minutes). Students make their own way to and from the centre.

Accommodation is arranged in standard twin rooms with shared bathroom facilities (single rooms available on request — supplement applies).

All families are carefully selected and inspected by the Kings Accommodation Manager.

Students under 16 are not given a house key.

### Meal Plan

Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day.

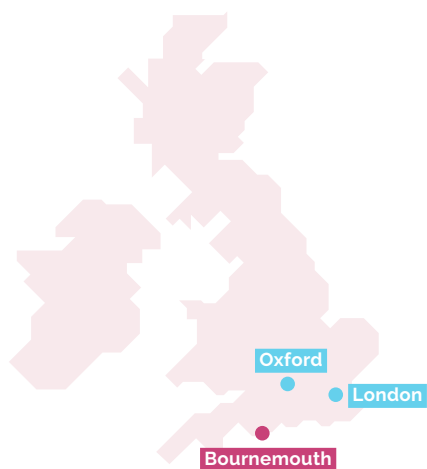
Lunch is a combination of hot lunches and packed lunches.
