# **PRIMARY ENGLISH PREPARATION PROGRAM** (PEP)

The Primary English Preparation Program specifically targets young learners who are seeking to learn English and continue their schooling in Australia. The learners typically may have only learnt some basic English at primary school and occasionally speak English with native speakers.

It is anticipated that Primary English Preparation program students will exit the PEP program and pathway to a mainstream primary school.

The other alternate pathway is for students to continue into the High School Preparation program at Shafston, then exit to a mainstream high school.

The age range for students is between 10 to 12 years old.

PEP course students must reside with a "nominated guardian" approved by the Department of Home Affairs.

\*Please note that any students under the age of 12 years old must have an adult chaperone with them at all times outside of the classroom hours.
















